Description

Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

In January, the organisational process was discussed and the kick-off of the project was announced on social media and websites. Representatives from 4 partner countries were present.

In April, an art residency took place in Ignalina, with 2 artists from each country (8 people in total), as well as one artist from an associate partner country. A total of 26 participants, 13 men and 13 women, took part in the Art Residency. The artists worked for a week on artworks - paintings on the theme of gender equality - and participated in events related to the project. Representatives from municipalities, cultural institutions, the tourism center and the University of the Third Age also participated in the residency and its events. The residency lasted 7 days and 81 people participated in the opening of the exhibition of the works created during the residency.

The residency included a meeting and a lecture about gender equality and the challenges we experience.

The artists' original works will be exhibited in the Ignalina Regional Museum for 1 month. After the exhibition, the photo panels for outdoor exhibition will be displayed in a public space, in a park by the lake, where they will be available for an unlimited period of time, and the original works will decorate the spaces of the municipality and cultural institutions. The chosen form of outdoor art allows the works to be seen at any time and without any restrictions.

The opening event was difficult to keep a gender balance and more women than men attended, no one spoke about the gender binary and we are unable to provide such information.

Total people of participating in residency is 26 people, in opening event 81.

The publicity activities of the project on the municipality's social networks and the posters produced by the municipality make it possible to spread the word about the project itself and its theme. The activities carried out during the project allowed to talk about gender equality in the sphere of art and the works created made it easier to communicate the topic to the public. The lecture and the creative activities carried out for the municipality's employees, the representatives of the cultural institution, the tourism institution and the visitors of the University of the Third Age allowed the knowledge of the participants to be raised and disseminated.
