## Description

The last event of the project took place on a sunny 21 September in Ignalina. It was the venue for a creative and autumn fair-festival. Ignalina residents and guests were invited to shop at the fair, visit the art alley, visit the courtyards of Ignalina district elders, communities and institutions, get acquainted with the craftsmen and artists of our region, their wonderful handicrafts, delicious meals, enjoy a great concert with guests from Latvia, Poland, the Czech Republic, and the great Aukštaitija armonica players.

The Maastricht Treaty was also presented in one of the tents at the fair, with a special lottery to present the Treaty's message in a playful way and to attract people's interest.

A more extended presentation was made through a slide show, which covered what has already been discussed during the project, as well as two educational videos on equality, and links to more information. The main points of the Maastricht Treaty and what everyone should know about it were presented. The same people who attended the festival watched the presentation and were also able to take part in a lottery about the Maastricht Treaty later on. The slides of the presentation in English are attached. But we have it in Lithuanian, we just can't attach it due to limited space in the system which doesn't allow us to submit documents.

It was a big event and it was difficult not only to keep the gender balance, but also to get everyone's signatures.

The list provided does not include the signatures of all those who took part as organisers and representatives, so the number could be even higher. We have focused on the list of people who were involved in spreading the word about the Maastricht Treaty.

This event was an opportunity to discuss the project and its events, as well as to share experiences and challenges, and to plan for the final reports and reporting, and it was the last live meeting of the whole project team and partners.
